## Notes on COVID-19

In response to the outbreak of COVID-19, we have elected to suspend all non-US and non-UK programs for the 2019/20 academic year.

This decision directly affects our Explorer program only, reducing the available destinations from 20 to 9.

All Accelerator, Explorer+ and Remote programs remain unaffected.

The driving force behind this decision is to allow us to allocate the full weight of our resources to our US- and UK-based programs, to most effectively support the interests of our, primarily US- and UK-based, student body.

To that end, we have also elected to increase the availability and accessibility of the following programs:

### CI<sup>X</sup>UC Merced Explorer+ Program, Los Angeles & San Francisco

Summer 2020 intake increased. Now open to all undergraduate and graduate students (previously limited to University of California students).

Extended [ISA alternative funding](#) option to Explorer+ program (previously limited to Accelerator students).

### Global Accelerator Program, New York and London

Summer 2020 intake increased.

### Global Explorer Program / Global Remote Program

Spring, summer & fall intake increased (for US and UK).
